



CHRISTMAS FINGER PUZZLE

You will need:

A4 paper

Pencils or textas

Scissors

Template





- 1. Using textas or pencils colour in where required.
- 2. Cut out the square along the outer lines. Do not cut any interior lines.
- 3. With picture side up, fold square in half. Unfold.
- 4. Fold in half the other direction. Unfold.
- 5. Flip paper over, picture side down. Fold the corners up and toward the centre.
- 6. Flip the page over again so that the word side is up.
- 7. Fold the corners up to the centre of the square.
- 8. You will now have a square with pictures up. Fold square in half.
- 9. Fold rectangle in half.
- 10. You should have a tiny square. Unfold until you have 8 pictures looking up at you again.
- 11. Place your fingers under each of the flaps in the back and "scrunch" the four corners up in the centre until they meet.
- 12. After the corners are lifted to the centre, you should see this image, but 3D.

TO PLAY:

- Have your child insert their thumb and index finger from each hand into the flaps in the back.
- Open and close the finger puzzle in different directions as you spell one of the words from the outer layer.
- · Then, pick a picture from the inside.
- Open and close the finger puzzle the number of times indicated on the picture you chose.
- Choose one more image.
- Open that flap and choose a number from one to four.
- Read the verse or question from the chosen number.
